LOBBYING UPDATE

A member asked:

Due to the Corona Virus shutdown, the Senate was unable to meet to vote on the legislation affecting our industry (Assembly Bill 655/Senate Bill 599), does that mean the bill is "dead"?

The short, simple answer...

AB 655 isn't dead and can still be taken up by the Senate in Extraordinary Session. If it is passed by the Senate, it would go to the Governor for consideration. It would not need to go back to the Assembly.

The longer, more complicated answer...

Senate Joint Resolution (SJR) 1 set the legislative calendar for the 2019-2020 Legislative Session. The last day of the 2019-2020 "Regular" Legislative Session was to be March 26, 2020, the last day of the last general floor session period. As part of SJR 1, any bill that has not passed both houses by that time "fails to pass."

However, Senate and Assembly rules allow for an Extraordinary Session to be called by the State Legislature to take up bills outside of the "Regular" Legislative Session. The bills that have "failed to pass" can be "revived" and taken up again (i.e. voted on). Bills that are "revived" would be taken up at the same stage of the legislative proceedings that it was at when the "regular" legislative session ended. So, AB 655 is considered to be amended and passed by the Assembly, passed by the Senate Committee and available for scheduling in the Senate (which means to be scheduled for a vote by the full Senate.) The Extraordinary Session can be called any time. Technically, the State Legislature could call more than one Extraordinary Session.

Will the Senate go into Extraordinary Session to take up bills that were pending before them before the public health emergency, like AB 655? At this time, I believe so, as do other lobbyists and legislators. But, admittedly, this is a situation no one has experienced before - we are in unchartered territory.



THE BULGING WALL: AN INSPECTION CLAIM

"The inspector should have noted the moisture issue on the base boards in his inspection, which would have led me to look into the issue before buying my home. I have contacted the inspector, and he came out to reinspect and send a revised report. I have also contacted the Board of Inspectors, who advised me to contact you, his insurance company."

One of our brokers received this email from a home inspection client of his insured, Ron Howard. With the client's claim escalating, Howard turned to our claims team for help resolving the complaint.



The Inspection of the Bulging Wall

In his report, Howard noted that the master bedroom was so cluttered that he could not fully inspect it. Howard also noted that the wall adjacent to the master bathroom had a visible bulge, which he recommended "should be explained and monitored." In his picture of the bulging wall, you can see a blanket rack obstructing the adjoining wall just beyond the door.

The Re-Inspection

In the re-inspection, Howard observed with the access panel open—which wasn't during his original inspection—dripping water. The shower drain was leaking and causing the plywood below to become soaked and damaged. When Howard went over the inspections' files, he discovered the picture he took with the blanket rack obscuring the bulging wall and access panel. Intentionally or not, the sellers had concealed the defect.

The Resolution

Howard's client ended up hiring an attorney who asserted that the limitation of liability clause in his contract was "not enforceable." Instead of the \$350 inspection fee refund Howard's contract proposed, the attorney demanded the Howard pay over \$10,500 for repairs. Our claims team assigned defense counsel, and Howard settle the claim for \$3,000. Howard was only responsible for his insurance deductible.

Key Takeaways

- Document everything you see: While you're only responsible to inspect what's visually identifiable, documenting everything you see helps to be able to prove what was and wasn't visible at the time of the inspection.

Affiliate members Attorney Roy Wagner and Attorney Lauren Triebenbach of Michael Best and Friedrich offer a risk-free, INITIAL consultation to WAHI members with legal concerns. WAHI members have the right to contact any attorney of their choice. Should a WAHI member decide to work with Roy or Lauren, the steps below, provided by Lauren, provide an explanation of their services.

- 1. If you receive an email, letter, text, or pleading from a customer, please contact our office. Lauren is generally more accessible than Roy, but feel free to call either of us.
- 2. We will ask that you provide us with the communication you received plus your inspection agreement and report. If there are other communications related to the claim, we will ask for those too.
- 3. After we review your documents, we will schedule a time to talk to you. Calls generally last 15-30 minutes. We will discuss with you your options, which could include working it out on your own, engaging us to respond on your behalf, or tendering the claim to your insurance company. The strategy we discuss will be based on your specific claim, whether litigation or arbitration has already been initiated, and whether your inspection agreement specifies arbitration as the method of dispute resolution.
- 4. If you don't hire us, you don't get a bill. If you do hire us, the time spent reviewing the case will be included in the final billing.
- 5. Knowledge is power. We want inspectors to know their options so they can the decision that's best for them and their business.
