

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Julie and I have been doing road trips to all the WAHI Chapters - it's been fun and a learning experience. From the WAHI State perspective, it is our obligation to empower each Chapter to be the best it can be, so seeing each Chapter in action is invaluable. Plus, it was great to see everyone besides at a spring or fall seminar. Thank you to everyone for your hospitality!

We are using our experiences to put together new ideas and suggestions on how to improve WAHI now and into the future. As we've stated previously, it is our goal to grow and strengthen WAHI to ensure our members get the best value for their money and find their membership experience to be worthwhile. WAHI is the "big dog" in the State of WI when it comes to home inspection issues. Making WAHI stronger will make it easier to ensure our voice is heard. A stronger WAHI, with greater public awareness, will help you as a member and as a home inspector.

An extremely important issue came to light during our "visits"...not all WAHI members are using the WAHI Inspection Agreement which contains the WAHI Arbitration clause. In my opinion, this is the number one benefit of your membership. Arbitration clauses authored by others (AHIT, etc.) do not compare to the clause in our Inspection Agreement. This is not shocking - agreements which must be somewhat generic for use in all states cannot be tailored to just Wisconsin.

The WAHI Inspection Agreement is <u>unique</u>. It was designed by WAHI <u>for</u> Wisconsin, using input from top Wisconsin attorneys, and most important, has been put through a number of legal challenges, has been thoroughly tested, and has been upheld in all cases. A recent challenge, which went all the way to the Appellate Court, was found in favor with our agreement/arbitration clause! See page 3 of the June 2017 WAHI Inspector for full details.

The WAHI Inspection Agreement is **available only to our members**. You can contact Julie to obtain one, but it is also available on the WAHI website under the Members Only tab. Our most recent revision was in October 2015 — make sure that is the one you are using. The WAHI Arbitration Clause is literally worth thousands of dollars in the event you find yourself in a dispute. I highly encourage you to take advantage of this incredible member benefit!

With each chapter visit, we stressed the importance of our ongoing effort to increase Affiliate membership and participation. Strong Affiliate membership provides direct benefits to our home inspector members. Through my observations, as relationships develop with Affiliate members, they welcome questions (and calls during a home inspection!) and can provide answers at a moment's notice. This benefit is of course in addition to them being the foundation of our pool of expert Contractor Arbitrators.

There are many new WAHI initiatives in the works also. I am planning to announce several of them at the Fall 2017 WAHI Seminar in the Dells. My thought is to give you an opportunity to share your opinions with us face-to-face. I'm hoping you will make time to join us November 3rd and 4th.

As I write this, we are still awaiting a response from the WRA on our proposed language for the home inspector legislative changes. The Wisconsin State budget proposals in the Legislature are in full-on negotiations, so while we have this at the top of "our" list, we realize it's probably not at the top of theirs. As previously reported, there aren't any significant changes which will affect how we do our thing – primarily just tweaks on the definition of defect. We are planning to provide training on any changes at the seminar this fall to ensure everyone is in compliance and doesn't put themselves in harm's way.

It's been a busy year so far, and everything points to it staying that way, but as usual, feel free to email or call me.




